My comment:

I have always warned against Charismatic leaders who have stopped sharing from the scriptures. One of them are Brian Houston, head pastor in Hillsong, Australia.

This shallow and quite fraudulent presentation of the similarities of Islam and Christianity falls into this category. If Muslims and Jews worshiped the same God of the Old Testament, that Jesus is obviously a “different god”. Funny that the Muslims who according to Brian Houston did worship God, did not understand that “god” suddenly changed.

Second: The Koran is written 1500 years after the Hebrew Bible. So up to 620 A.D, there was no Muslims walking on the face of the Earth. No even one.

So, since the Muslims had to wait for 600 years after Jesus walked on the face of the Earth before they understood who God is, they must have worshiped “god” in retrospect.
